## Homeless Shelter Program

L.A. Family Housing has three homeless shelters providing emergency and transitional housing for individuals and families. Our more than 600 bed capacity is strengthened by comprehensive supportive services on site at each shelter including:

- case management
- life skills training (including parenting classes, family budgeting and money management)
- medical and mental health services
- drug and alcohol recovery programs
- employment counseling and job retention support
- professional and casual clothing
- transportation assistance
- computer labs for adults and youth
- adult literacy programs
- permanent housing search and placement assistance
- three nutritious meals daily in an on-site cafeteria
- legal advocacy
- licensed child care for preschool children
- school enrollment and reintegration services
- children's after school enrichment activities and homework assistance
- hygiene supplies, including diapers for infants

## Shelter Locations

Sydney M. Irmas Transitional Living Center – North Hollywood, CA

- provides 260 emergency and transitional beds for children and their families in private units per family

Trudy and Norman Louis Valley Shelter – North Hollywood, CA

- provides 250 emergency and transitional beds for homeless individuals

Comunidad Cesar Chavez Family Shelter – Boyle Heights, CA

- provides 140 emergency and transitional beds for children and adults in private units per family
